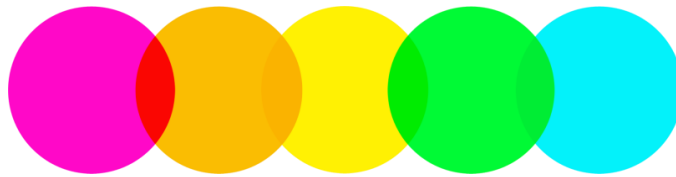


COLOR THEORY ART STUDIO

AND UPDATED AS OF (SUMMER 2021)
COVID-19 PROTOCOLS



CHANGES to how things will be ran at Color Theory Art Studio due to the Covid-19 Pandemic and Recent NYS Guidelines and Protocols:

Our Staff is STILL TAKING PRECAUTIONS seriously:

Color Theory is owned and run by Cassandra Wickert who has run the studio for 10 years and wishes to keep her students, staff and family safe! She is also a mom who has taken every single precaution to keep her family safe during the entire pandemic. We feel that we can open safely and do this right - to not only protect your children but to protect us as well.

Helping to CONTROL the spread of Covid-19 within the studio but also relaxing some of the previous mandates:

- In the studio, staff will be cleaning constantly, using CDC recommended cleaning products. [L] [SEP]
- ALL STAFF MEMBERS ARE VACCINATED and have provided necessary proof of vaccination to have on file. Teachers will not be required to wear masks during our

open enrollment classes/camps/workshops within the studio unless a private group or class requests that the staff still wear a mask.

- Any areas used by children during class/camp will be sanitized after they leave. [SEP]
- All children are spaced out with 6' between them as best as possible seated on opposite sides of our 6' long tables. This is why our maximum capacity is lower than usually but we are able to fit 16 kids comfortably in the studio.
- We will limit the number of children allowed to attend class and not “squeeze” any extra [SEP] children in, as to keep as much distance as we can between all students. [SEP]
- We are opening up our half hour snack break during our 3 hour camps/workshops where children are free to eat in the studio.

THERE ARE NO GUARANTEES – You are sending your child at your own risk:

The studio and staff are taking the necessary precautions and abiding by the rules and regulations of the CDC. We will be doing everything we can to keep the studio clean, sanitized and safe! In sending your children at your own risk, you cannot hold Color Theory, or it's employees responsible for any illness that your child may contract.

SUPPLIES! Purchasing a supply kit (NOW OPTIONAL):

We would like our classes to run as smoothly as possible.

There are some staple supplies that students will individually use for each lesson such as: Scissors, glue stick, paintbrushes, crayons, pastels, pencils, markers etc. These individual materials will be set in a designated bag for your child and put in a container that is solely for their class. All supplies that do not need to be shared such as paper, clay, canvas, glue and specialty materials will be given to your child in the studio. ONE supply kit should last your child for the entire semester of classes, should they run out of a specific supply, purchasing individual supplies is possible!

ENTERING THE STUDIO:

We've always enjoyed weekly check-ins and updates on family matters and how our students have been. For now, it is hard but we have to enforce a **NO ADULTS** policy. We ask that your child be dropped off either by you, a guardian, babysitter etc. outside of our glass front door. You can stand and watch through the window but you may not enter.

ARRIVING AT THE STUDIO:

Please make sure your child understands we are social distancing for safety and we have implemented new protocols!

- We ask that you come 5-10minute before the start of class and wait outside the studio, standing 6' apart from the other children being dropped off by their parents.^{[[SEP]]}
- We will meet you at our front entrance. We will admit each child one by one.^{[[SEP]]}
- Your child will have their temperature taken upon

entry. If your child has been sneezing, coughing, has a stomach ache, or has appeared sick in any way you are NOT permitted to drop your child off. [L] [SEP]

- Parents/guardians will be asked if any signs of sickness or behavior has changed since their child's last visit and supply any additional information that may relate to their participating in class that day.

- Children are NO LONGER REQUIRED to wear a mask in the studio but it is still STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.

- Child will use provided hand sanitizer to sanitize their hands and thoroughly wash hands using supplied soap whenever necessary.

[L] [SEP] PICK UP WHEN CLASS IS OVER:

We cannot stress enough how very important it is that you arrive ON TIME to pick your child up. We have to clean and get ready for the next class and we need all children out of the studio to do so properly. [L] [SEP]

- Parents will wait outside the glass doors and our staff members will dismiss children one at a time.

- Your child will bring their artworks even if not completed if parent does not wish to leave them on the drying racks.

[L] [SEP] SO MANY RULES, STILL SO MUCH FUN!

Our staff is just as enthusiastic and dedicated as ever to having our students enjoy their art classes and fun! We will still learn, discuss, create, make jokes, sing, have fun and be with our classmates and teachers in a safe environment!

PAYMENTS

All payments must be made in advance, online, using a credit card.

REFUNDS

At this time we must adhere to our studio policy and issue all refunds onto your personal Color Theory studio account as a studio credit to be used for future classes/camps/workshops etc. We are sorry for the inconvenience but our classes/camps/workshops are prepped and staffed according to enrollment and we cannot issue credit card/cash refunds.

We will continue the online classes for as long as there is a demand for it! We are here for you and your children. We know that everyone has a different threshold of what they feel is safe, and we want to honor that by being as versatile as we can in our offerings, while still maintaining safety!
